I. Purpose

a) #PantherPraise was created to emphasize members of our campus community that are doing great things. This is a friendly competition to get everyone involved with recognition and to create a more positive environment at Pitt!

II. Teams

- a) Each individual team shall be as follows: Forbes, Holland, Lothrop, Nordenberg, Panther-Irvis, The Quad, Sutherland, Tower A, Tower B-Gold, Tower B-Blue, Tower C, ASLAC and NRHH.
- b) Members of Residence Halls shall be the Hall Council members, Floor Representatives, and any Residents of their respective hall.
- c) Members of the ASLAC shall be the Advocacy Council members and any other Residents in apartment style-living on campus.
- d) Members of NRHH shall be members of the Jonas Salk Chapter.

III. Facebook Challenges

- a) #PantherPraise 2018-2019
 - i) This Facebook group is open to everyone involved with the Hall Governance Program.
- b) **5 points** will be awarded for each comment on a Challenge
- c) Must specify team to earn points.

IV. #PantherPraise

- a) This hashtag can be used on Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram.
- b) Must specify their team to earn points.
- c) Accounts must be public in order for points to be counted.
- d) Photos can also be submitted to any RSA or NRHH social media using #PantherPraise
- e) All appropriate submissions shall be worth **3 points**.

V. #MemberMonday

- a) All Resident Students may nominate another Resident to be featured on RSA's social media for a #MemberMonday Spotlight.
- b) A submission can be made by emailing rsa@pitt.edu or a direct message to any RSA social media accounts (Instagram, Twitter and Facebook: @rsapitt). Included should be the following:
 - i) A photo of the individual to be featured (for social media posts)
 - ii) Their year, major(s), and position (if any), and residence hall.
 - iii) What have they done recently that deserves this award? Please use specific examples.
- c) Every submission shall be worth **5 points** each.

VI. OTM Submissions

- a) OTMs may be submitted at otms.nrhh.org
- b) If an OTM is submitted, **10 points** will be awarded. If the OTM wins on a campus, regional, or national level, an additional **5 points** will be awarded for each win.

VII. Recognition

- b) Awards shall be given out for the greatest number of points for first, second, and third places at the annual RSA-NRHH Recognition Banquet.
